# Resolved issues in this release

The following issues have been resolved in this release.

## **New HTML parsing implemented**

If HTML content in an email message contains a style block, which does not hide the content as a comment, then the style block is corrupted. This can result in the whole of the HTML content not being shown if viewed within Microsoft Outlook.

The new HTML parsing module implemented in this release handles this issue, while taking into account policy sensitivity to ensure messages are delivered or quarantined according to your settings.

## **High memory usage**

Blank lines in a quarantined message header were causing high memory usage.

## **Permissions issue for policies**

Administrators could not see all details or make per-user antispam changes in a policy for which they had permissions.
