- Be at least 8 characters
- Contain at least 1 upper case character
- Contain at least 1 lower case character
- Contain at least 1 number
- Contain at least 1 non-alphanumeric character

The Audit Log under TRITON Settings has been updated in this release. Events are now added to the log in the following cases:

- A single administrator permission is added or removed.
- Administrator details are modified i.e. several different permissions are changed and/or check boxes are selected or cleared. Click the link in the event notification to see full details of the changes.
- Two-factor authentication is added, removed, or modified.

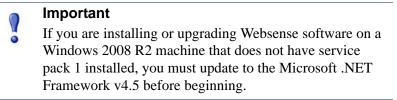

To upgrade to TRITON APX version 8.1, all deployments of TRITON AP-WEB, AP-EMAIL, AP-DATA, Web Filter, Web Security, and Web Filter & Security must be at version 7.8.x or later.
