Installation USB Drive

This document provides information to use the installation USB drive to re-image the McAfee® Firewall Enterprise Control Center Management Server.



Re-imaging the Management Server will overwrite all data that is currently stored on the Management Server.

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Re-image the Management Server

Use the installation USB drive to re-image the Management Server.

Task

- 1 On the client computer, copy the ccinit.txt file to a USB drive that is different from the installation USB drive (hereafter configuration USB drive).
For more information about ccinit.txt, see the *McAfee Firewall Enterprise Control Center Product Guide*.
- 2 Make the installation USB drive bootable.
 - a Insert the installation USB drive into a USB port.
 - b Follow the instructions in the readme.txt file on the installation USB drive. Depending on the operating system of the computer, run the bootstk or bootstk.bat script.
- 3 Remove the installation USB drive from the computer, and insert it into one of the USB ports on the Management Server.
- 4 Connect the Management Server to a monitor and keyboard.
- 5 Turn on the Management Server.
- 6 Configure boot settings.

C1015, C2050, and C3000 models	All other models
The system automatically boots from the installation drive. Go to Step 8.	<p>1 When the F11 = Boot menu line appears, press F11 repeatedly until the line changes and a boot menu appears.</p> <p>2 Select Hard drive C. From the submenu, select Front USB or Back USB, then press Enter.</p>

- 7 When prompted, remove the USB drive and press **Enter**. After the installation is complete, press **Y** to reboot.



The installation USB drive is no longer bootable.

- 8 After the **GNU GRUB** screen appears, press **Enter** or wait for five seconds.

- 9 The **EULA** screen is displayed. Accept the license agreement.

The system setup begins.

- 10 When you receive the following message, insert the configuration USB drive that contains ccinit.txt into one of the USB ports. Wait several seconds and press **U** to rescan the USB drive. You might have to repeat this step.

The configuration information loads into the Management Server. The Management Server restarts.

- 11 At the "Please remove the USB" prompt, remove the USB drive. The configuration is completed, and the logon prompt appears.

The re-imaging process is complete.
