

# Enhanced Management Interface for i-Series Appliances and Edge Devices

TRITON AP-WEB Cloud has been updated with a new device management interface. The new interface provides an easier and more efficient way to manage and configure i-Series appliances and edge devices. It offers the ability to:

- Organize devices into folders for streamlined management
- Find devices via search
- Perform bulk operations to update multiple devices at the same time
- Access device details from within the Device Management page, without opening a sub-page or pop-up

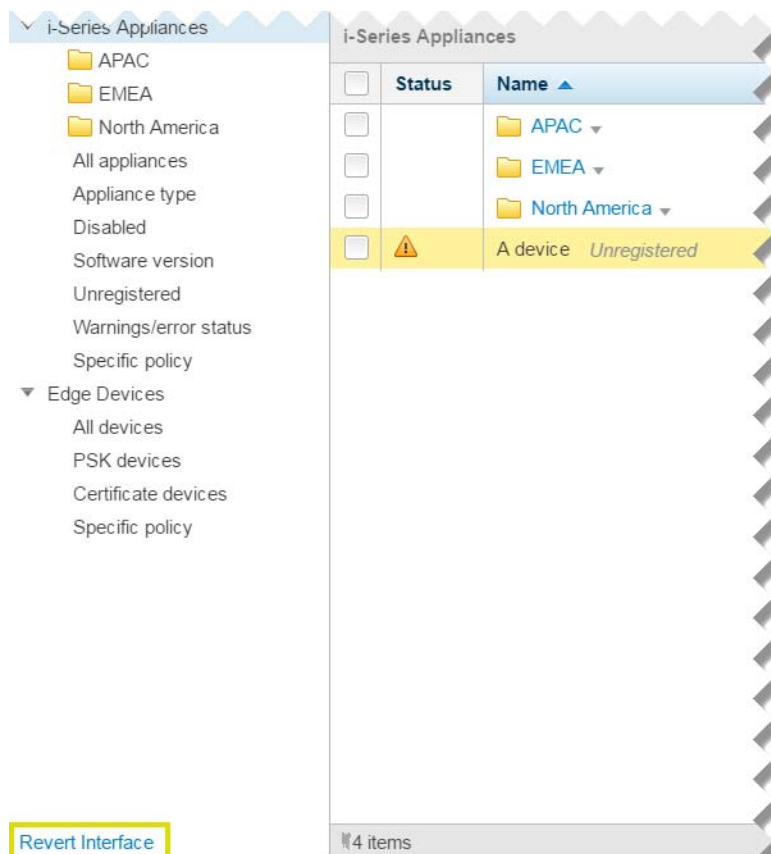
