Compatibility with V-Series 7.5.x

Web Security Gateway running on Websense V-Series appliances at version 7.5.x (up to v7.5.3) is compatible with v7.5.1 off-box Web Security components (such as Network Agent, Filtering Service, and Policy Server). No upgrade is required for the appliance itself.

Preparation

Back up your servers before upgrading.

- When upgrading to v7.5.1 from v7.0.x or v7.1.x, note that configuration settings in mng.xml cannot be saved. Before upgrading, take note of your settings in mng.xml (by default located in C:\Program Files\Websense\tomcat\conf\Catalina\localhost or /opt/Websense/tomcat/conf/Catalina/localhost directory).
- ♦ When you upgrade to 7.5.1 from v7.0.x or v7.1.x, custom settings for the variable PolicyServerWaitTime in **websense.ini** (located by default in C:\Program Files\Websense\bin) are not saved. After upgrading, open the **websense.ini** file in the installation directory and make sure parameter settings reflect your desired configuration. .
